



Rules and regulations

The administration of Estancia Bahía Esperanza cannot be held responsible for possible accidents that occur as a consequence of natural phenomena, nor by the carelessness, poor preparation or inappropriate behavior of visitors.

For your safety, we have developed a set of rules that you must follow at the moment of your visit:

- It is absolutely forbidden to litter on the trails and in the woods. People who picnic should take their waste off the premises, without leaving any trace. Littering is considered a serious breach of the park rules.
- Camping inside the park is strictly prohibited, except for guided groups with authorization from the administration.
- The entry of camping equipment such as tents, sleeping bags, pots and cookers is not allowed.
- It is forbidden to light fire on the trails, near them, or anywhere outside.
- Smoking is prohibited inside the premises.
- It is forbidden to wash in the lagoons or estuaries (any garment or artifact).
- Do not alter, move or damage infrastructure.
- It is forbidden to fish or enter fishing equipment without authorization from the administration.
- The entry of kayaks, canoes, hard or plastic boats, stand up paddle, or any other type of nautical vessel is not allowed. They are also prohibited all kinds of water gadgets.

- The entry of motorcycles, different than the ones owned by Estancia Bahía Esperanza, is not allowed.
- Pets are not allowed due to the effects they may have on wildlife.
- The entry of horses, other than the ones owned by Estancia Bahía Esperanza, are not allowed.
- It is forbidden to cut trees, flowers, ferns, or collect any plant or animal sample of the ranch. Nature must not be disturbed.
- Do not touch reptiles, amphibians or insects.
- Do not feed the animals sighted on the route (birds included), or leave food outdoors, since the native fauna can get used to this food and leave its wild state.
- It is forbidden to enter weapons.
- It is forbidden to hunt animals.
- It is forbidden to enter drones without authorization from the administration.
- Park rangers are present to enforce park regulations and it is their duty to report any infraction in it.
- Estancia Bahía Esperanza reserves the right to permanently prohibit the entry to those who deliberately violate the regulations of the enclosure, without prejudice to legal actions that may be taken against offenders and the other penalties and fines that may be applied by the administrative authorities, like SAG or CONAF.
